Summer Camp for 2024 is Saturday (3rd Feb) through to Tuesday morning (6th Feb) at Napier Beach. I know its a long time away but because its Waitangi weekend, accommodation needs to be booked now to get into the Top 10.

Below is all the info from Becs

## 2024 Summer Camp

There is a deadline for the **accommodation being held UNTIL 18.03.2023** if you wish to secure a room, site, motel etc. at the Top 10.

**There is a minimum 3 night stay required due to being a long weekend.**

**\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$Booking requires a 50% deposit to be paid by 30.04.2023\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$**

**PLEASE NOTE in 2024 Waitangi Day is a TUESDAY - Summer camp will run from Saturday morning (3rd Feb) thru to Tuesday morning (6th Feb). Although people may start to arrive on Friday night there is nothing formal being arranged at this stage. We will be there from Friday arvo / evening.**

We have arranged (through the manager: Renee Lawton) to stay at Top 10 in Napier Beach (this camp is in Bayview - the old Snapper Park), Hawkes Bay.

You can go onto the website to have a look at the park / facilities etc but you will note you can't book anything - so you need to call to book. I have *attached* a photo of the map for the camp too and will make a few notes about this later in the email.

- They are happy to hold rooms until 18.03.2023 while individual people call thru and book directly (please mention you are with the Capri Car Club of NZ)
- Top 10 members will get their 10% and all non-members will be able to get 5% of the below prices.
- Bookings require a **deposit (50%) needs to be paid by 30 April 2023** and a non-cancellation period after 1 December 2023 will apply to all bookings.
- If covid was to hit credits would be held

**All prices below are base rate for 2 people**

**Beachfront motels \$220 a night (4 of these available) –**



Our beachfront motel rooms have the beach right on their doorstep. Located on the beach front, these units have stunning coastal views and can cater for up to five people. Serviced daily - Free WiFi - Basic equipped kitchen (microwave, small benchtop oven, toaster, electric kettle, fridge, electric hot plates) - Separate bedroom with 3 bunk beds - King-size bed in main room - Separate bathroom - Dining table & chairs - Heat pump / Air con - Freeview tv - Hairdryer - Iron & ironing board - Picnic table

**Beachside motels \$200 a night (4 of these available):**

Our beachside motel rooms are set back a stones throw away from the beach. These rooms offer limited coastal views and can cater for up to five people.

Serviced daily - Free WiFi - Basic equipped kitchen (microwave, small benchtop oven, toaster, electric kettle, fridge, electric hot plates) - Separate bedroom with 3 bunk beds - Queen-size bed in main room - Separate bathroom - Dining table & chairs - Heat pump / Air con - Freeview tv - Hairdryer - Iron & ironing board - Picnic table

**Chalets \$180 a night (3 of these available)**



Stand-alone sunny cabin in the park with covered deck and outdoor seating. Free WIFI - Microwave, electric fry pan, toaster, electric kettle, bar fridge - Queen-size bed, set of single bunks - Separate bathroom - Dining table and chairs - Heat pump/ Airconditioning - Freeview TV - Short walk to ocean Maximum occupancy: 4 people

**Ensuite cabins \$155 a night (7 of these available)**



Our ensuite cabins are stand alone units located throughout our park. These units are self contained with cooking capabilities (please see below) and their own bathroom. Although these units don't offer sea views they are only a short stroll away from the beach and can cater for up to five people.

Open plan cabin with parking space next to the cabin - Free WiFi - Kitchenette with crockery and cutlery. Microwave, electric frying pan, toaster, jug and bar fridge - Queen-size bed with single bunk bed above - 2 single bunks - Separate bathroom - Dining table and chairs - Ceiling fan, heater - Freeview TV - Picnic table - Bedding and towels provided

**Basic cabins \$100 a night (5 cabins available)**

**PLEASE NOTE Showers cost \$1 coin for 4 mins**



Our basic cabins are stand alone units located throughout our park. These units can sleep up to four people. These cabins share the camp facilities/amenities as there is no plumbing in these units. Although these units don't offer sea views they are only a short stroll away from the beach.

- Bedding configuration differs with units, all units sleep maximum of 4 guests - Shared park kitchen, showers (coin operated) and toilet - Free WiFi - TV - Heater - Picnic table

**AS STATED ABOVE - THEY ARE ALL PRICED BASED ON 2 ADULTS - Extra adults are \$30 per night and children are \$20.**

**Park House (3 bedroom, full kitchen with 2 bathrooms) - The cost will be \$400 a night (for the first 4 people) then plus \$30 per adult after that.**

- Bedroom 1 = 2 sets of bunks
- Bedroom 2 = 2 sets of bunks plus 2 singles

- Bedroom 3 = 2 singles

We did not look inside the house and I can only say I understand it to be of basic standard. See bottom right of map for location.

**Camp sites-** (powered and unpowered) - prices vary depending on location - please confirm with them directly.

We understand all rooms / chalets / cabins etc come with bedding, linen and towels.

**The camp kitchen** is currently pretty small and they are planning (no guarantees) to upgrade and extend this in the next 12 months. There is a good outdoor area with a number of decent sized Webber BBQ's.

**There is a cafe** attached to the camp as well (open to the public as well) open for breakfast and lunch and also has some evenings that it stays open in the summer. Not sure if will be open in the evening this particular weekend yet (located on map bottom left in the same building as the reception).

We have spoken to them about possibility of catering, as well so there are many options being looked into (with time on our side for this) but if you hang out for a nice coffee or a cooked brekkie then this is a short stroll from your room, tent etc.

There is a barrier arm with coded entry for security.

**THE MAP (please ignore all the prices and scribbles on it as the prices are now confirmed as above less the 5% or 10% discount):**

Top right where the pen is pointing - this is the area with the Beachside Motels and Beach front Motels, along with 4 non-powered camp sites. There is a no parking sign at the end of "Seaside Ave" and if we get the Motel rooms all booked up, then we propose to erect a marquee or two in this no parking area (weather permitting etc) and make this a sole use area for the club.
